Tents, Canopies and Temporary Membrane Structures	\$25.00 - 200 – 1000 sq. ft.

5. Test of Water Tanks with a Type 1 Engine	\$218.00 per hour* (Minimum charge one hour)
6. For use of outside consultants for plan checking and inspections, or both	actual costs**
